

# Lesson - 1

**Aqeedah** The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said:

بُنِيَ الْإِسْلَامُ عَلَى خَمْسٍ: شَهَادَةِ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَأَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا رَسُولُ اللَّهِ

**Translation:** Structure of Islam is based on five Pillars:

To testify that there is no god except Allah, and that Muhammad ﷺ is the Messenger of Allah.

**Qur'an** Revise Surah Fatihah and Surah Ikhlāas with translation.

**Hadeeth** The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said:

أَحَبُّ الْبِلَادِ إِلَى اللَّهِ مَسَاجِدُهَا، وَأَبْغَضُ الْبِلَادِ إِلَى اللَّهِ أَسْوَاقُهَا

**Translation:** The parts of land dearest to Allah are its Masaajid, and the parts most hateful to Allah are markets. (Muslim: 671)

**Dua**

اللَّهُمَّ أَعِنِّي عَلَى ذِكْرِكَ وَشُكْرِكَ وَحُسْنِ عِبَادَتِكَ

**Translation:** O Allah help me in remembering You, in giving You thanks and worshipping You well. (Abu Dawood: 1522).

**Seerah** In the first two to three years after the revelation, the Prophet ﷺ preached Islam secretly to individuals whom he trusted. When he started calling people to Islam publicly, the new religion gradually attracted more people but, People of Makkah started to harass Him.

**Akhlaaq** Manners of entering into Masjid:

1. Prepare to leave for Masjid as soon as you hear Azaan.
2. Dress well when you go to the Masjid. Walk in dignified manner, don't run while going to Masjid.
3. Do not eat smelly food before going to Masjid. If you do, brush your teeth and make sure bad odor is not there.
4. Put right leg first while entering into Masjid.
