Aqeedah The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said:

بُنِيَ الْإِسْلَامُ عَلَى خَمْسٍ: شَهَادَةِ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَأَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا رَسُولُ اللَّهِ،
وَإِقَامِ الصَّلَاةِ، وَإِيتَاءِ الزَّكَاةِ، وَالْحَجِّ،

Translation: Structure of Islam is based on five Pillars: To testify that there is no god except Allah, and that Muhammad ﷺ is the Messenger of Allah, and to establish Salah (prayer), to give Zakah (charity), to perform Hajj,

Qur'an

إِذَا جَاءَ نَصْرُ اللَّهِ وَالْفَتْحُ ﴿١﴾ وَرَأَيْتَ النَّاسَ يَدْخُلُونَ فِي دِينِ اللَّهِ أَفْوَاجًا ﴿٢﴾

Hadeeth

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said:

مَنْ لَا يَرْحَمُ لَا يُرْحَمُ

Translation: Anyone who does not show mercy will not be shown mercy. (Bukhari: 5651)

Dua

رَبَّنَا لَا تُرِغْ قُلُوبَنَا بَعْدَ إِذْ هَدَيْتَنَا وَهَبْ لَنَا مِنْ لَدُنْكَ رَحْمَةً
إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ الرَّؤُوفُ

Translation: Our Lord, let our hearts not deviate after You have guided us and grant us from Yourself mercy. Indeed, You are the Bestower. (Aal-Imran:8)

Seerah

People of Makkah, and especially Quraish – a famous clan of Arab in Makkah- tried very hard to stop people from accepting the Islam. They imposed economic and social sanctions on the Prophet ﷺ and his followers. As a result, the Muslims withdrew to a mountain in Makkah. The sanctions lasted about three years and ended without achieving their goals.

Akhlaaq

The rights of parents have such a great importance in Islam that Allah almighty has ordered it in Qur'an along with His rights, to be good to parents.
