

## Lesson - 6

**Aqeedah** The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said:

بُنِيَ الْإِسْلَامُ عَلَى خَمْسٍ: شَهَادَةِ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَأَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا رَسُولُ اللَّهِ،  
وَأَقَامِ الصَّلَاةَ، وَإِيتَاءِ الزَّكَاةَ، وَالْحَجَّ، وَصَوْمِ رَمَضَانَ.

**Translation:** Structure of Islam is based on five Pillars: To testify that there is no god except Allah, and that Muhammad ﷺ is the Messenger of Allah, to establish Salah (prayer), to give Zakah (charity), to perform Hajj and fasting in the month of Ramadan. (Bukhari:8)

**Qur'an** Revise Surah Nasr with Tajweed.

**Hadeeth** The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said:

لَا يَدْخُلُ الْجَنَّةَ مَنْ لَا يَأْمَنُ جَارَهُ بَوَائِقَهُ

**Translation:** A person whose neighbors are not safe from his evil will not enter the Jannah. (Muslim: 13)

**Dua**

اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّكَ عَفُوٌّ كَرِيمٌ تُحِبُّ الْعَفْوَ فَاعْفُ عَنِّي

**Translation:** O Allah! You are most forgiving, generous and You love forgiveness; so forgive me. (Tirmidhi: 3513)

**Seerah**

Soon afterward, Prophet's wife Khadija R.A passed away. Matters got worse quickly with the death of his uncle and protector Abu Talib. As a result, Prophet Muhammad ﷺ started to suffer more from the people of Makkah.

**Akhlaaq**
