تَبَّتْ يَدَا أَبِي لَهَبٍ وَتَبَّ ۚ مَا أَغْنَىٰ عَنْهُ مَالُهُ وَمَا كَسَبَ ۚ
سَيَصِلَىٰ نَارًا ذَاتَ لَهَبٍ ۚ

Hadeeth

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said:

إِنَّمَا الصَّبْرُ عِنْدَ الصَّدْمَةِ الْأُولَىٰ

Translation: Patience should come with the first shock. (Bukhari: 1223)

Dua

رَبِّ اشْرَحْ لِي صَدْرِي ۙ وَيَسِّرْ لِي أَمْرِي ۙ
وَاحْلُلْ عُقْدَةً مِّنْ لِّسَانِي ۙ يَفْقَهُوا قَوْلِي ۙ

Seerah

This spread of Islam further angered the people of Makkah. They decided to increase their efforts against Prophet Muhammad ﷺ and Muslims. Before the Prophethood, people of Makkah loved and respected Muhammad ﷺ. They called him Al-Ameen and As Sadiq. He was a successful businessman and everybody loved to do business with him. But when the Messenger of Allah ﷺ announced the Prophethood, most of them opposed and became his enemy.

Akhlaaq

Manners of Greetings:

1. Saying complete salaam i.e. **السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ وَرَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ وَبَرَكَاتُهُ**
2. Be first in greeting (saying Salam).
3. Greeting (saying Salam) to everyone whether he be an older or younger than you.
4. Greeting (saying Salam) with a smiling face.
