Aqeedah

The third pillar of Islam is Zakah (giving charity) which means Purification. Here, Zakah means to purify the wealth and soul by giving a little portion of the wealth to those who in need.

Qur'an

تَبَّتْ يَدَا أَبِي لَهَبٍ وَتَبَّ ۚ (١) مَا أَغْنَىٰ عَنْهُ مَالُهُ وَمَا كَسَبَ ۚ (٢)
سَيَصْلَىٰ نَارًا ذَاتَ لَهَبٍ ۚ (٣) وَأَمْرَاتُهُ حَمَّالَةَ الْحَطَبِ ۚ (٤) فِي جِيدِهَا حَبْلٌ مِّن مَّسَدٍ ۚ (٥)

Hadeeth

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said:

لَيْسَ الشَّدِيدُ بِالصَّرْعَةِ، إِنَّمَا الشَّدِيدُ الَّذِي يَمْلِكُ نَفْسَهُ عِنْدَ الْغَضَبِ

Translation: The strong man is not the good wrestler; but the strong man is he, who controls himself when he is angry. (Bukhari: 5763)

Dua

رَبِّ اشْرَحْ لِي صَدْرِي ۙ (٢٥) وَيَسِّرْ لِي أَمْرِي ۙ (٢٦)
وَاحْلُلْ عُقْدَةً مِّن لِّسَانِي ۙ (٢٧) يَفْقَهُوا قَوْلِي ۙ (٢٨)

Translation: My Lord, expand for me my chest. And ease for me my task. And untie the knot from my tongue. That they may understand my speech. (Taha: 25-28)

Seerah

Not only other people of Makkah became Prophet's enemy, but even his family members also opposed Him. One of His own uncle Abu Lahab who loved him before, did not leave any chance to harm and torture him.

Akhlaaq

Manners of Greetings:

1. Use always meaningful words like Salam, Fi-amanil-lah, and avoid meaningless words.
2. If you forget to say Salam, say it when you remember.
3. If anybody is sleeping then do not say Salam loudly.
4. When you are greeting someone who is at a distance then you may show with hand while saying Salam.
