

How to use this book

About the book

Complete Tajweed is taught in Book – 01 and Book – 02 in easy steps, which can be taught in grade 1 and 2 respectively. “**Book – 01: Lets Read Al Qur'an – the easy way with Tajweed**” is for beginners. It is designed to fit into the school curriculum which can spread over an entire academic year. It can also be taught in higher classes if needed.

Book – 01 is divided into two sections:

- **Section A** covers the Read Al-Qur'an.
- **Section B** covers the Islamic Studies.

Section A: Lessons **01 to 12** cover the Arabic letters with focus on learning the shapes, the sounds and the writing practice. Lessons **13 – 33** covers the Harakaat (vowels). Sight and Sound vocabulary is developed in these lessons with enough practice. The appendix covers the note to the teacher on how to teach letters with the help of stories.

Qur'an Lab activities are given in the teacher's guide. These lesson-wise activities reinforce the concepts learnt. The activities ensure student engagement with the subject and will result in high quality of learning.

Section B: This section has Islamic studies divided into simple monthly lessons. Each monthly lesson has Aqeedah, Dua, Hadeeth, Akhlaaq, Seerah and Qur'an. All topics are chosen in a way that are easy to understand and relevant to the students' life. The Surahs that are recited daily are to be memorized along with Duas, morning & evening Azkaar, etc.

Course organization

1. To successfully complete the course, a minimum of 3 periods per week are required.
2. It is better to have a UQA certified teacher for teaching this course. Visit our website for teacher training certification.
3. The course can be taught with the help of presentations and videos in a smart classroom.
4. The course material consists of textbook, workbook, presentations, videos, posters, flashcards, games, and a teacher's guide.
5. Qur'an Lab activities are a part of the course to enhance the learning and increase student engagement.

Assuming 30 weeks are available in an academic year with 3 periods per week, a sample schedule is given below:

Sample schedule (3 periods/week. Total 90 Periods)

Lessons 1 – 12 require two periods per lesson. First period have the explanation and practice of the letters while the second period will have Qur'an Lab where workbook and related learning activities are carried out.

Total Periods: 24 periods

Lessons 13 – 33 require two periods per lesson. First period have the explanation of concepts while the second period will have Qur'an Lab component where learning is enhanced through activities.

Total Periods: 40 periods

Islamic Studies (8 lessons) 2 periods per lesson.

Total Periods: 16 periods

Quiz, Exams and Revisions require 10 periods.

Total periods: 10 periods
