مخرج وف: "Waaw" is pronounced with both the lips forming a circle, then separating to produce the sound. "Faa" the lower lip touches the edge of the upper teeth to produce this sound.

The full and the short forms of Waw and Faa are given in the first line. The same forms with connectors are given below.

NOTE: Waw و is very thin so it has no short form. It does not mean that it cannot be connected to other letters. Any other letter before it can be connected to Waw.
