Soft Yaa (يِ)

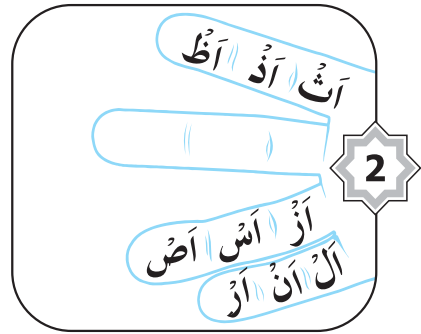
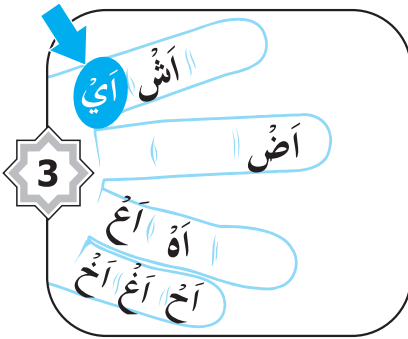

If a Fathah-letter is followed by Yaa-Saakinah (يِ) then it should be pronounced softly, as you say it in Dubai, eye, or fly. Only a few cases of Soft Yaa with its full form are there in the Qur'an. These are given below the poem.

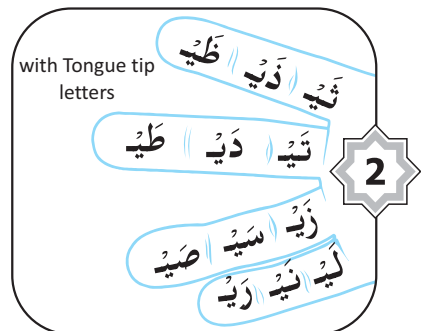
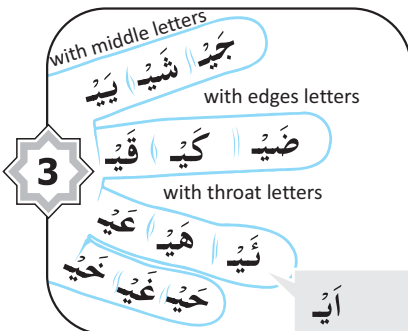
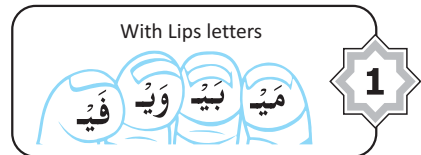
Soft Yaa's Poem

Here Soft Yaa (يِ) example is given by Alif with Fathah (أ). But Soft Yaa can come after any letter.



Now we will recite the poem with a soft-Yaa attached to all the letters. Note that the soft-Yaa sound in every case is from the middle of the tongue.

This form of soft Yaa is used in Quran frequently.



Soft Yaa in its full form
