مخرج : هَ، هِ : Hamza / Ha are from the lower part of the throat near the heart, 'A'in / é a are from the middle of the throat.

The full and the short forms of هَ Hamzah and هِ Haa are given in the first line. The same forms with connectors are given below. But one line is connected with it.

NOTE: Sometimes, Alif, Waaw and Yaa become the chair of Hamzah, Hamzah sits on them.

أُؤِ Hamzah sign is written over Waaw and Yaa but generally not written on Alif in those Mushaf which printed in Asia.
