Rules of Meem Sakinah (مُ)

then suppress Meem-sakin with Ghunnah while keeping the lips joined and then say Baa. In this book, the Sukoon sign on such a Meem is slightly rotated ().

يَعِظُكُمْ بِهِ

and you would cleanse them thereby

He admonishes you with it

اَمْ بَعِيْدُ

اَيَامُرُكُمْ بِالْكُفُرِ

Rule-02: Merge: When a Meem with Sukoon is followed by Meem, then they are merged.

لَهُمْ مَّا

يَأْتِكُمُ مُّثَلُ

Rule-03: Express: When a Meem-with-Sukoon is followed by any other letter, then read أَ normally.

Caution: When a Meem-with-Sukoon is followed by Waaw or Fa, then make sure that you say أَ clearly.

There is a chance that you may not touch the lips while reading أَ أَ gou are not careful.
