Show (Izhar)  
(to show Noon Saakinah & Tanween)



If a Noon-Saakinah (Noon with a Sukoon: نْ) or a Tanween is followed by any of the throat letters ع، ح، غ، خ then pronounce the نْ or the Tanween clearly. Just read it in normal way. This rule is also applied in Tanween, because Noon ن is hidden in Tanween. **Note:** Letter will not be read if there is no Sign on them.
