Dua

(Al-Mu'minun:118) رَبِّ اغْفِرْ وَارْحَمْ وَأَنْتَ خَيْرُ الرَّحِيمِينَ

Hadeeth

(Bukhari: 3759) إِنَّ مِنْ أَحَبِّكُمْ إِلَيَّ أَحْسَنَكُمْ أَخْلَاقًا

Translation: The most beloved to me amongst you is the one who has the best character and manners.

Akhlaaq

Manners at home:

1. Say Salam (greetings) while entering the house.
2. Keep your belongings (like the clothes, shoes and school bags etc.) at their suitable place. Prompt in time and at suitable place. Formula: **jab ka jab - jahan ka wahan!**
3. Follow a fixed time table so that you complete all your important tasks.
4. Obey parents and do not displease them. Seek for a chance on how to make them happy and satisfied.
5. Sleep early at night and wake up early in the morning.

Seerah

(Al Ahzab:21) لَقَدْ كَانَ لَكُمْ فِي رَسُولِ اللَّهِ أُسْوَةٌ حَسَنَةٌ
