Ageedah

Iman (believing in Allah) is the greatest reward of Allah that he has bestowed upon us.

Dua

Hadeeth

Akhlaaq

Manners at home:

- 3. Follow a fixed time table so that you complete all your important tasks.
- 4. Obey parents and do not displease them. Seek for a chance on how to make them happy and satisfied.
- 5. Sleep early at night and wake up early in the morning.

Anas Bin Malik reported that the Messenger of Allah was the best amongst people in disposition and behavior. (Muslim: 2310) He welcomed people with a Salam and Smile. People flocked around him just to see his radiant face and hear his good and motivational talk.
