Aqeedah

Allah has prepared Hell for His disbelievers and evil slaves wherein they will get every type of punishment because they disbelieved and disobeyed Allah.

Dua

(Al-Isra: 24) رَبِّ ارْحَمْهُمَا كَمَا رَبَّيْنِي صَغِيرًا

Translation: O my Lord! Have mercy on both of them as they brought me up when I was small.

Hadeeth

The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم said: Beware! Avoid sitting on the roads (ways). The people said: There is no way out of it as these are our sitting places where we have talks. The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم said: If you must sit there, then observe the rights of the way. They asked: What are the rights of the way? He said: They are the lowering of your gazes, refraining from harming people, returning greetings, advocating good and forbidding evil. (Bukhari: 2465)

Akhlaaq

Manners when you go out of home:

1. Walk on the foot path and not on road.
2. Do not play or run on the road.
3. Hold on to your Mother or father's hand.
4. Remove the harmful things (stone/thorns) if you see in the path.
5. Say Salam to the passers-by.

Seerah

Abdullah Bin Amr narrated that the Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه وسلم never used bad language. Neither he was "Fahish" nor a "Mutafahish" (an ill-tongued or a quarrelsome/ troublemaker). (Bukhari: 3559)
