هُوَ، هُمْ

Before learning Arabic Grammar we should make our mind and remember well that whenever we learn any part of Arabic Grammar we will learn it through TPI (Total Physical Interaction). It means: Thinking it with mind, seeing with eyes, hearing with ears, telling with tongue, showing with hands, reading with heart (love) and studying together. By using this method we can learn the Arabic Grammar easily and in an interesting style.

In this first lesson of Arabic Grammar you will learn two words which occurred in Qur'an repeatedly. These two words are هُوَ، هُمْ. Remember them well and learn their translation (meaning) with understanding. Now, let us practice these two words. Make sure to practice them with TPI.

Arabic Word	Translation
هُوَ	He
هُمْ	They

Now we will practice these words joining with Muslim مُسْلِم and Muslimoon مُسْلِمُونَ in order to learn /understand these words perfectly well and to use them in our sentences easily. For now, just remember that هُوَ will be used with مُسْلِم and هُمْ will be used with مُسْلِمُونَ.

Take a deep breath and practice هُوَ، هُمْ joining with مُسْلِم or مُسْلِمُونَ (Muslim and Muslimoon) and make sure to use TPI during practice

Arabic Word	Translation
هُوَ مُسْلِم	He is a Muslim
هُمْ مُسْلِمُونَ	They (all) are Muslims

Spoken Arabic

Now we will take a New Arabic word مَنْ (who) and practice Spoken Arabic with this new word. Make sure this practice is also required to do with TPI.

Question	Answer
مَنْ هُوَ؟	هُوَ مُسْلِم
مَنْ هُمْ؟	هُمْ مُسْلِمُونَ
