Plural Feminine: The rule for making their plurals is to replace ة with ات at the end. There are other rules as well that you will study later.

Following words are the examples of Feminine Plural form. Understand it and Practice it.

| Singular Feminine | Plural Feminine |
|-------------------|-----------------|
| مُؤْمِنَةٌ | مُؤْمِنَاتٌ |
| مُسَلِّمَةٌ | مُسَلِّمَاتٌ |
| صَالِحَةٌ | صَالِحَاتٌ |
