Lesson 7

Aqeedah

Those people whom Allah choses especially to convey His message, are called Messengers or Prophets. About 25 Prophets are mentioned in the Qur'an by their names.

Dua

Translation: O Allah, the Turner of the hearts, turn our hearts to Your obedience.

Hadeeth

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said:

آيَةُ الْمُنَافِق ثَلَاثٌ: إِذَا حَدَّثَ كَذَبَ، وَإِذَا وَعَدَ أَخُلَفَ، وَإِذَا اؤْتُمِنَ خَانَ (Bukhari:33)

Translation: The signs of a hypocrite are three: When he speaks, he tells a lie; and when he promises, he breaks his promise; and when he is entrusted, he betrays (proves to be dishonest).

Akhlaaq

Friday is a special day. It is advisable to take bath and wear neat clothes, sending Salawaat (blessings) on Prophet Muhammed and recite Surah Kahf. Use perfume and go to the Masjid as early as possible, before Khutbah (sermon) starts. Do not disturb the people in order to go to the front rows. Sit wherever you get the place easily. Listen to Khutbah with attention. Do not talk or do any unnecessary action while Khutbah is going on.

Seerah

During Hajj in the 11th year of Prophethood, the Messenger of Allah met six persons of Khazraj tribe who came from Madinah. He called them to the religion of Allah, Islam. They accepted it with sincerity. After going to Madinah they introduced Islam to their tribes and Islam spread from house to house in Madinah.
