- means to abrogate, abolish, or repeal.
- When the Qur'an is revealed as the final book replacing Tawrah, Bible, and earlier scriptures, some of the previous commands (such as Friday instead of Saturday; or Ka'abah as Qiblah instead of Baitul Magdis) were changed.
- Some Jews objected to it and started creating doubts in the minds of Muslims. They said: If the book is from Allah only, how can the commands change?
- 3 Allah says: We know what is best for people in different times and when to teach something better and new; We have power over everything.
- Everything belongs to Allah alone, and His alone is the dominion. Here Allah invites us to reflect on His kingdom and His power.
- Allah's dominion spreads far and wide beyond what you can see and imagine. Feel your helplessness and insignificance when a tsunami, an epidemic, or a storm is approaching? You can only call upon Allah for safety.
- Imagine the huge systems in this universe, many of which we don't even comprehend, like the growth of vegetation, the animal and insect kingdoms, the food cycle, the water cycle, the ozone protection system, etc.

Hadith: Abu Bakr as-Siddiq RA said: Messenger of Allah! command me something to say in the morning and in the evening. He said: Say

"O Allah, Creator of the heavens and the earth, Who knows the unseen and the seen, Lord and Possessor of everything. I testify that there is no god but You; I seek refuge in You from the evil within myself, from the evil of the devil, and his (incitement to) attributing partners (to Allah)." (Abu Dawud: 5067)

Imagine & Feel: Feel happiness that the one who created such a huge universe is our Guide and our Helper. He will never leave us alone. He is always there to help us, guide us, and protect us in the face of all the opposition against Islam.
