




## Grammar Lesson-19a: Fourth Pair (that shows relation) with pronouns




In this lesson we will learn the use of pronouns in the pair that shows relations. For example, we will take **بَيْتُ اللَّهِ** instead of **بَيْتُهُ**.

- There will be an effect on pronouns: **نَا، كُمْ، ي، ك، هُ، هُمْ، هُ، هُ**. Let us use this pair in sentences and practice with TPI.

examples	states		
<b>هَذَا بَيْتُهُ</b>	Original state (رفع state)		<b>بَيْتُهُ</b>
<b>دَخَلَ زَيْدٌ بَيْتَهُ</b>	When there is effect (نصب state)		<b>بَيْتَهُ</b>
<b>زَيْدٌ فِي بَيْتِهِ</b>	After preposition (جر state)		<b>بَيْتِهِ</b>

**Note:** For the third case, instead of **بَيْتِهِ** it is read **بَيْتِهِ** for the convenience.

- Let us take another examples with a female pronoun.

examples	states		
<b>اللَّهُ رَبُّهَا</b>	Original state (رفع state)		<b>رَبُّهَا</b>
<b>أَعْبُدُ رَبَّهَا</b>	When there is effect (نصب state)		<b>رَبَّهَا</b>
<b>أَعُوذُ بِرَبِّهَا</b>	After preposition (جر state)		<b>رَبِّهَا</b>

- Let us look at the effect of preposition on such pairs.

If you have <b>مِنْ</b> + a pair of relation		If you have <b>بِ</b> + a pair of relation	
<b>مِنْ رَبِّهِ</b>	←	<b>رَبُّهُ</b>	<b>بِرَبِّهِ</b>
<b>مِنْ رَبِّهِمْ</b>	←	<b>رَبُّهُمْ</b>	<b>بِرَبِّهِمْ</b>
<b>مِنْ رَبِّكَ</b>	←	<b>رَبُّكَ</b>	<b>بِرَبِّكَ</b>
<b>مِنْ رَبِّي</b>	←	<b>رَبِّي</b>	<b>بِرَبِّي</b>
<b>مِنْ رَبِّكُمْ</b>	←	<b>رَبُّكُمْ</b>	<b>بِرَبِّكُمْ</b>
<b>مِنْ رَبِّنَا</b>	←	<b>رَبِّنَا</b>	<b>بِرَبِّنَا</b>
<b>مِنْ رَبِّهَا</b>	←	<b>رَبُّهَا</b>	<b>بِرَبِّهَا</b>
