



Miracle: Qur'an is easy

Course-1 (on Salah) gives us 50% words

But here is another miracle:

Surah Al-Baqarah does not have that many new words. Therefore, in this Surah, you already know 6 out of 9 words/line!



- Each Juz in the most commonly printed Mushaf has 20 pages.








C2: Page -1, Pointer -a

A Juz/para is divided into 4 parts. Each Quarter has 5 pages.








In this course, we will study first 5 pages or 1st Quarter.

A pointer may have more than one topic.





Benefits of Pointers

- Pointers give you the context in which the new words are being used.
- They work as anchors for you to memorize the meanings and recall them..
- They help you visualize the subject of the page
- Very useful in memorizing the Qur'an

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Phrases

I often ask in my workshops: What is the meaning of:

And many people give answer!

Phrases

- It means that they know the answer but in a phrase and not alone.
- THAT IS THE WAY TO LEARN VOCABULARY.
- Memorize phrases and not words.

Phrases

- Instead of memorizing the meaning of ان (if) and شاء (willed) separately, memorize the meanings of ان شاء الله
- Instead of memorizing the meaning of صمد, let us memorize the meanings of الله الصمد.
- Instead of memorizing the meaning of يقيمون, let us memorize the meanings of يقيمون الصّلاة

Phrases

- Provide anchors for our brain to remember the meanings of new words.
- Help you remember the message.
- make more sense than just words.

Memorizing phrases and their meanings is much more effective, powerful, appealing, and useful than memorizing just words & meanings.



Al-Fatihah & the start of Al-Baqarah is taken as Page-1 in order to have 20 pages for Juz-1.








Ta'awwuz & a part of Al-Fatihah

- You have already studied these parts word-by-word in the course "Understand Al-Qur'an & Salah".
- We will talk of 12 excellent habits that will lead us to success in-sha-Allah.
- Word-by-word study will start from Al-Baqarah, i.e., after two lessons.



Recite Ta'awwudh before reciting the Qur'an so that Shaitan does not:

- whisper you during Tilawah
- Stop you from pondering the verses
- Stop you from getting guidance



For starting general things, we recite Bismillah so that we get Barakah from Allah in it.

When we start reciting the Qur'an, we say: A'oodhu billah. Why? B'cos Qur'an is full of Barakah and Shaitan will try his best to stop us from it. So, we need protection.



Implement this Zikr in day-to-day life:

• Habit #1: Safety first! Recite it whenever Shaitan whispers you. Realize that you are under continuous attacks from Shaitaan and you need to seek protection.

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

B sound of Bismillah

- Sorting order right to left
- Highlighter with blue color; KEEP the paper in front of you
- Smile; clear throat; say it loud as practice;
- TPI-plz
- Explain the new word (Show TPI for that; and then ask 3MSI (I for I of Madi) but say: So, what will be "he ...")
- Repeat the Arabic verse till that part with TPI actions. We are like deaf people, so TPI actions help us.
