

Let us take a verb which has a Hamzah in it: أَمَرَ. Its table will be like: نَصَرَ يَنْصُرُ. Note the following while making its forms:

- Sometimes Hamzah works like a weak letter. For example, Hamzah will disappear in order form: مُرٌ.
- When two Hamzahs come together, the second one becomes a Madd. اأْمُرُ → اْمُرُ.

(The boxes show the 3 verb keys and the 3 noun keys)

He ordered : 199 أَمَرَ:

فعل أمر فعل نهى. اسم فاعل، اسم مفعول، اسم فاعل		فعل مضارع	فعل ماضٍ
Order!	مُرٌ	He orders / will order	He ordered
Order! (you all)	مُرُوا	They order / will order	They ordered
Don't order!	لَا تَأْمُرْ	You order / will order	You ordered
Don't order! (you all)	لَا تَأْمُرُوا	I order / will order	I ordered
the one who orders	امِر	You all order / will order	You all ordered
The one who is ordered to order; order	مَأْمُور	We order / will order	We ordered
	أمر	She orders / will order	She ordered

Spoken Arabic

نَعَمْ، يَا مُرُّ بِالصَّلَاةِ.	هَلْ يَا مُرُّ بِالصَّلَاةِ؟
نَعَمْ، يَا مُرُّونَ بِالصَّلَاةِ.	هَلْ يَا مُرُّونَ بِالصَّلَاةِ؟
نَعَمْ، امِرُّ بِالصَّلَاةِ.	هَلْ تَأْمُرُّ بِالصَّلَاةِ؟
نَعَمْ، نَأْمُرُّ بِالصَّلَاةِ.	هَلْ تَأْمُرُّونَ بِالصَّلَاةِ؟

After the class try to have dialogues among yourselves using:

- فعل ماضٍ: هَلْ أَمَرْتُ بِالْمَعْرُوفِ؟ نَعَمْ، أَمَرْتُ بِالْمَعْرُوفِ.
- فعل أمر: مُرُّ بِالْمَعْرُوفِ! سَوْفَ امِرُّ بِالْمَعْرُوفِ.
- اسم فاعل/اسم مفعول: هَلْ أَنْتَ امِرُّ بِالْمَعْرُوفِ؟ نَعَمْ، أَنَا امِرُّ بِالْمَعْرُوفِ.

Just like أَمَرَ, you can make the complete table for أَحَذَّ (he took). You can find other verbs too on this style.
