iv. Why Hameed and Majeed are mentioned at the end of Durood (the prayer for the Prophet ﷺ)?

Q-3. Questions on general applications of Qur'an / Adhkaar in our life.

i. If I am worried about completing my tasks /business/studies and it is time for Salah, which phrase of Adhan tells me that Allah will surely grant success if I go to Salah?
