

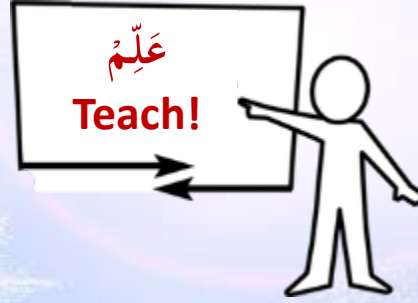

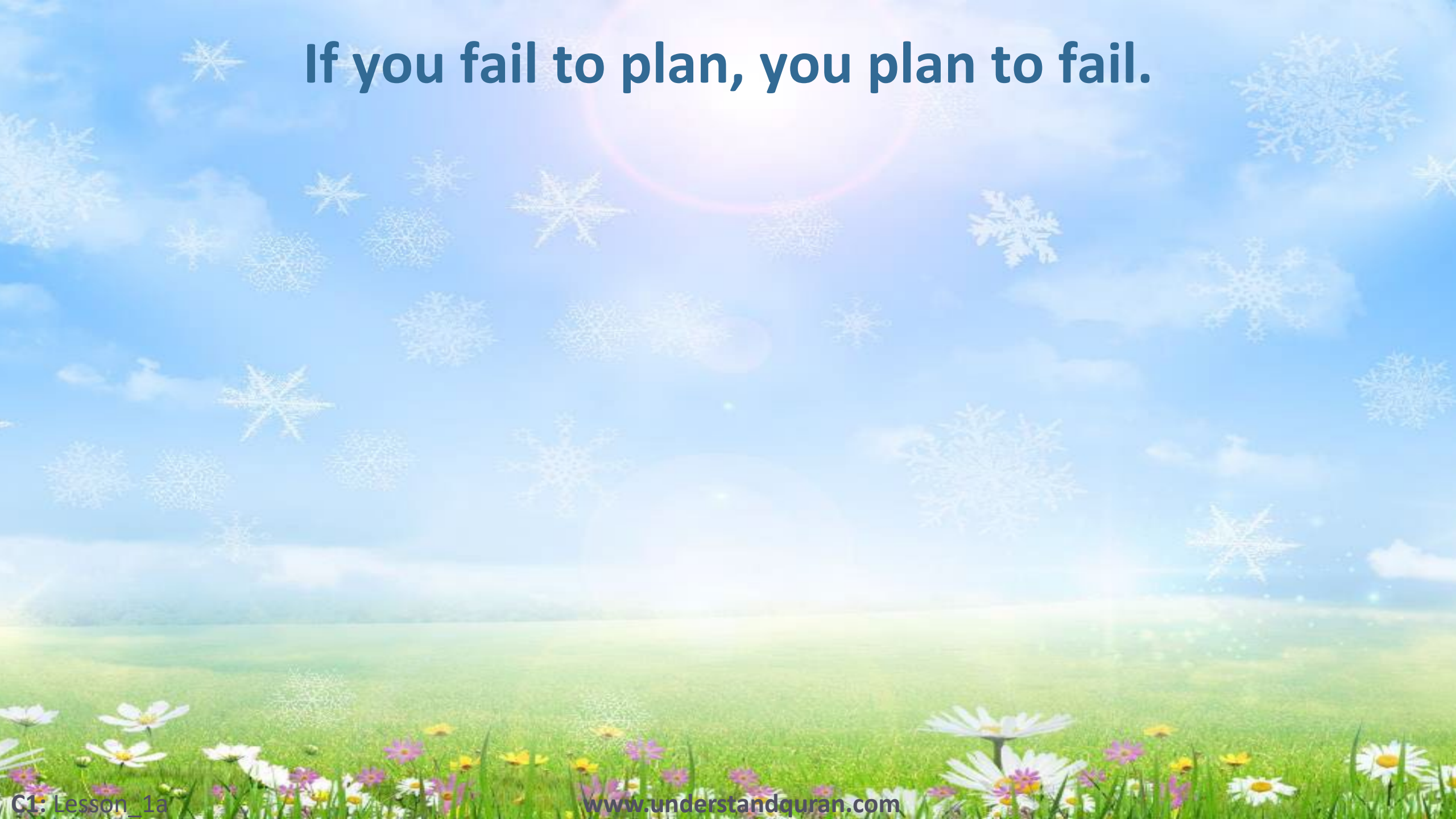

One of the biggest challenge

For proper Salah is Waswasah! The whispering of Shaitan in Salah.

Let us check our brain first.

We can work on 5 things at time: 5 channels of our brain

Example: when you drive, you:

- Control the steering
- Control the breaks
- Talk to you friend
- Watch the road
- Look for your shop ...

While praying, keep all the channels busy

- Recite
- with tajweed
- Understand what you recite
- Visualize what you recite
- Feel it & interact with it

If not...

Shaitan will attack you easily and destroy your Salah.

Humanly, it is almost impossible to keep focus in Salah, if you don't understand what you recite.

This course will focus on understanding Salah and interacting with each Dhikr.

- **We recite without feelings!** (If your secretary talks slowly, with attention, but without feelings. Will you like that? And that's how we pray! A salah without any feelings or emotions!)

Waswasah

One of the Sahabah complained to the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) about waswas during prayer, and he said: “The Shaytan comes between me and my prayers and my recitation, confusing me therein.”

The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: “That is a devil called Khanzab. If he affects you, seek refuge in Allah from him and spit dryly to your left three times.”

the solution to Waswasah

He (the Sahabi) said, I did that and Allah took him away from me. (Narrated by Muslim, 2203)
