Rule # 1

م + ب

يَعْظُكُمْ بِهِ

At the beginning of  
2<sup>nd</sup> word

At the end of 1<sup>st</sup>  
word

Recite with Ghunnah

(Possible Reason: Meem may be suppressed)

تَرْمِيهِمْ بِحِجَارَةٍ

يَعْظُكُمْ بِهِ

Shaddah on the 2nd meem to show the merger with Ghunnah

Rule # 2

م + م

لَهُمْ مَا

فَمِنْهُمْ مَنْ

لَهُمْ مَا

When a Meem-with-Sukoon is followed by any other letter, then read م Normally.

Rule # 3

الْحَمْدُ، أُنْعَمْتَ

Take care of م when it is followed by و and ف because their makhraj is closer to م

هُمْ فِيهَا

عَلَيْهِمْ وَلَا الضَّالِّينَ
