

Whether it is Noon Sakinah or Tanween the ending sound is the same: 'n'  
Therefore, the rules are same.



Makhraj of Noon Sakinah is Tongue Tip, If another tongue tip letter comes after it...



Then we have conflict. Therefore we hide the sound of Noon Sakinah

How?

Keep your tongue tip close to the makraj of ت without touching it and do the Ghunnah.

Just like

**PINK,**

**SINK, ZINC**

(but extend the sound in Arabic)

مِنْكُمْ

Ghunnah



Keep your tongue tip close to the makraj of ظ (very thick & high) without touching it and do the Ghunnah.
