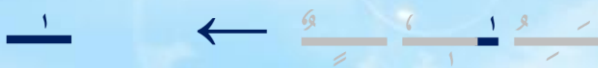

Rule #2: Standing Fathah will remain as it is.



Stop with an Alif- Madd in the following cases:

Rule # 3: If the word ends with double fathah then stop with Alif Madd

Rule # 4. If the last letter has Shaddah, stop it with Shaddah (without Harakah).

If the last letter has Shaddah on ن or م stop with Shaddah and ghunnah.

If the last letter has Shaddah on Qalqalah letters (ق ط ب ج د ن) then make sure to stop with the strongest qalqalah so that people are aware of it.
