This also reveals that during prayer times, Satan prepares his attacks, hence, to safeguard against these assaults, it's crucial to keep the great attributes and power of Allah in mind and seek refuge in Him.

- Allah's name is mentioned first, followed by salutations on Prophet Muhammad ﷺ. As after Allah's grace, the prayers were taught to us by Prophet ﷺ.
- Salutations for the Prophet ﷺ means, "O Allah! Shower Your blessings upon Prophet Muhammad ﷺ be merciful to him and elevate his name and status."
- Sending peace upon the Prophet ﷺ means: May the Prophet's name not be harmed or dishonored in anyway in this world, and in the Hereafter, he receives all kinds of peace.
