He who dies without associating with Allah anything will enter Jannah.



(Muslim: 93)

- Protect your Iman and stay away from sins that can damage it. Because having Iman is the basic condition to enter Jannah.
- In other words, entering paradise without Iman is not possible under any circumstances.

How to protect Iman?

The Messenger of Allah عنا المناقبة said:

He who dies without associating with Allah anything will enter Jannah.




(Muslim: 93)

- Protect your Iman from every action that may deprive you of Jannah in the hereafter.
- Keep praying that O Allah! Grant us complete Iman. Protect us from associating partners with You and from all minor and major sins.







To whom we should seek help? (1)

The Messenger of Allah عنائلية said:

And if you seek help

then seek help from Allah!

وَإِذَا اسْتَعَنْتَ

فَاسْتَعِنُ بِاللهِ

(M|uslim: 93)

- In some tasks, we need the help of others, like our mother cooking for us or our teacher assisting us in acquiring knowledge, etc.
- But there are certain tasks for which we should seek help only from Allah, because no human can assist in those matters. Such as giving us Tawfeeq to worship, providing sustenance, allowing us to enter Jannah, etc.





To whom we should seek help? (2)

The Messenger of Allah مِنْ اللَّهُ said:

And if you seek help then seek help from Allah!

وَإِذَا اسْتَعَنْتَ فَاسْتَعِنْ بِاللهِ

(M|uslim: 93)

 Remember that whether a task is related to this world or the hereafter, we need Allah's help in everything we do. This is because if Allah does not assist us, we cannot accomplish any task.





To whom we should seek help? (3)

The Messenger of Allah عَلَيْكُ said:

And if you seek help then seek help from Allah!

وَإِذَا اسْتَعَنْتَ فَاسْتَعِنْ بِاللهِ

(Muslim: 93)

- Action: Seek help from Allah before engaging in any good deed. Have complete trust that Allah will surely help you.
- Dua: O Allah! Make us those who seek help only from You for every task and make all our endeavors easy through Your grace.





What will happen in heaven? (1)

The Messenger of Allah عُلِيَّالِيُّ said:

He who would get into Paradise

(would be made to enjoy such an everlasting) bliss that he would neither become destitute,

مَنُ يَدُخُلُ الْجَنَّةَ يَنْعَمُ لَا يَبْأَشُ

(Muslim: 2836)

In the life of the world, a person whether good or bad - sometimes gets
happiness and sometimes has to face
sorrow and trouble. He has to bear the
sufferings like illness, anxiety, grief of
someone's death etc. But all these
things are limited to the world.





What will happen in heaven? (2)

The Messenger of Allah الطُّهُ said:

He who enters Paradise

will be in (an everlasting) bliss; he will not become destitute.

مَنُ يَدْخُلُ الْجَنَّةَ يَنْعَمُ لَا يَبْأَشُ

(Muslim: 2836)

In the life after death, Allah has prepared paradise for His pious and obedient servants, in which there will be only blessings, ease and comforts. In paradise, there will be no pain, suffering, or trouble of any kind. No one will be sick, nor become old, or die in paradise.





What to do to go to the heaven?

The Messenger of Allah الطُّهُ يَالِيَا said:

He who enters Paradise

will be in (an everlasting) bliss; he will not become destitute.

مَنْ يَدْخُلُ الْجَنَّةُ يَدُ

(Muslim: 2836)

- To go to Jannah, it's important to do good deeds. So, keep doing as many good deeds as possible and stay away from bad deeds.
- Make Dua that O Allah! Give us
 Taufeeq to do good deeds. Grant us
 entry into Jannah by Your grace and
 protect us from hell.





Who will go to heaven?

The Messenger of Allah الطُّهُ يَتِياً said:

He who obeys me will enter paradise, and he who disobeys me has refused

مَنُ أَطَاعَنِيُ دَخَلَ الْجَنَّةَ وَمَنُ عَصَانِيُ فَقَدُ أَلِي

(Bukhari: 7280)

- Follow the Sunnah of Prophet
 Muhammad ## and encourage others to
 do the same.
- Allah says: "He who obeys the Messenger has obeyed Allah." (An-Nisa: 80)
- Those who reject the obedience to Prophet Muhammad ** will be deprived of entering Jannah.
