Revision (Qur'an)

By serving parents, a believer becomes entitled to heaven. (وَصَاحِبُهُمَا فِي الدُّنْيَا مَعْرُوفًا)

- Parents get irritated due to old age or illness, but still live with them well. (وَصَاحِبُهُمَا فِي الدُّنْيَا مَعْرُوفًا)
- Call everyone by good and loving names! (يُبْنِيَنَّ--)

Revision (Hadith)

- To get any action accepted by Allah, keep His pleasure and the way of the Messenger of Allah in front of you! (إِنَّمَا الْأَعْمَالُ بِالنِّيَّاتِ--)
- Keep your actions and intentions good, Allah sees them both. (يَنْظُرُ إِلَى قُلُوبِكُمْ وَأَعْمَالِكُمْ)
- Be entitled to a full reward for having good intentions! (حَسَنَةً كَامِلَةً--)

Order people to do good! (2)

Ask people to do good or prevent them from evil. If people hurt you, do not leave this work but continue it with wisdom and patience.

Revision (Qur'an)

Before you give advice to anyone, try to win his heart. (يُبْنِيَّ--)

- Use wisdom when you ask people to do good or prevent them from evil.
(وَأْمُرْ بِالْمَعْرُوفِ وَانْهَ عَنِ الْمُنْكَرِ)
- Ask people to do good and forbid them from evil. If they hurt you, continue with patience.
(وَاصْبِرْ عَلَىٰ مَا أَصَابَكَ)

Revision (Hadith)

- If a person does something for Allah's pleasure only, he will be counted in Allah's path.
(فَهُوَ فِي سَبِيلِ اللَّهِ)
- We all make mistakes every day. Therefore, we must repent every day. (وَاللَّهِ إِنِّي لَأَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ ----)
- Success and honor in this world are given to those who have humility. (لِلَّهِ أَشَدُّ فَرَحًا ---)

The Messenger of Allah, peace be upon him, said: " No one will enter Paradise who has even a mustard-seed's weight of arrogance in his heart." (Ibn Majah: 59)



Don't walk arrogantly!

وَلَا تَمْشِ فِي الْأَرْضِ مَرَحًا

exultantly

in the earth

And (do) not walk

(Luqman: 18)

The one who walks arrogantly is disliked by Allah and also by humans. No one respects a person who walks like this!



Revision (Qur'an)



- Don't be rude, even if you are facing someone poor. (وَلَا تُصَعِّرْ خَدَّكَ لِلنَّاسِ)
- The one who has arrogance even a little arrogance will not enter Paradise. (وَلَا تُصَعِّرْ خَدَّكَ لِلنَّاسِ)
- The one who walks arrogantly is disliked by Allah and also by humans. (وَلَا تَمْشِ فِي الْأَرْضِ مَرَحًا)

Revision (Hadith)

- We should always be prepared for death. How? By cleaning ourselves from sins through repentance. (إِنَّ اللَّهَ عَزَّ وَجَلَّ يَقْبَلُ تَوْبَةَ الْعَبْدِ---)
- Do not run after desires and greed because there is no end to them. (أَحَبُّ أَنْ يَكُونَ لَهُ وَاذْيَانٍ)
- Seek help through patience. (وَالصَّبْرُ ضِيَاءٌ)

If a person is angry and still speaks in low voice, it helps him to control the anger.

Revision (Qur'an)

- Don't walk like a meek or sick person nor arrogantly. Be moderate. (وَاقْصِدْ فِي مَشْيِكَ)
- Speaking the truth does not require a loud voice. (وَاعْضُضْ مِنْ صَوْتِكَ)
- Speaking in low voice helps in controlling the anger. (وَاعْضُضْ مِنْ صَوْتِكَ)

Revision (Hadith)

- Patience prevents a person from submitting to evil people. (وَمَنْ يَتَصَبَّرْ يُصْبِرْهُ اللَّهُ)
- Through patience, a person does not give up in problems. (وَمَنْ يَتَصَبَّرْ يُصْبِرْهُ اللَّهُ)
- A believer uses the prosperity for worship & charity. (إِنْ أَصَابَتْهُ سَرَّاءٌ شَكَرَ)
