Do good to parents!



(Lugman: 15)

Parents may become irritated due to old age or illness, but Allah's decree is to be with them in the best manner. In it lies the test for everyone.





Speech in the best way



(Luqman: 17)

"يَا بَنِيَّ" means *"O my son!"*

Always address your elders, children and common people with good words and nice names!





By serving parents, a believer becomes entitled to heaven. (وَصَاحِبْهُمَا فِي الدُّنْيَا مَعْرُوْفًا

- Parents get irritated due to old age or illness, but still live with them well.
 (وَصَاحِبْهُمَا فِي الدُّنْيَا مَعْرُوفًا)
- Call everyone by good and loving names!
 (اینئنی)

Revision (Hadith)

- To get any action accepted by Allah, keep His pleasure and the way of the Messenger of Allah in front of you! (اِثْمَا الْأَعُمَالُ بالنِّيَّاتِ۔)
- Keep your actions and intentions good, Allah sees them both. (يَنْظُرُ إِلَى قُلُوبِكُمْ و أَعْمَالِكُمْ)
- Be entitled to a full reward for having good intentions! (حَسَنَةٌ كَامِلَةً...)






Open the heart first!

Ask people to do good or prevent them from evil. If people hurt you, do not leave this work but continue it with wisdom and patience.

 Use wisdom when you ask people to do good or prevent them from evil.
 (وَأَمُرُ بِالْمَعْرُوفِ وَانْهَ عَنِ الْمُنْكَرِ)

 Ask people to do good and forbid them from evil. If they hurt you, continue with patience.
 (وَاصْبِرْ عَلَىٰ مَاۤ اَصَابَكَ)

Revision (Hadith)

 If a person does something for Allah's pleasure only, he will be counted in Allah's path.

(فَهُوَ فِئ سَبِيْلِ اللهِ)

- Success and honor in this world are given to those who have humility. (--- الله أَشَدُ فَرَحًا



Don't be rude, even if you are facing someone poor.





Don't be arrogant! (2)



(Lugman: 18)

The Messenger of Allah, peace be upon him, said: "No one will enter Paradise who has even a mustard-seed's weight of arrogance in his heart." (Ibn Majah: 59)



Don't walk arrogantly!



(Luqman: 18)

The one who walks arrogantly is disliked by Allah and also by humans. No one respects a person who walks like this!





- Don't be rude, even if you are facing someone poor. (وَلَا تُصَعِّرُ خَدَّكَ لِلنَّاسِ)
- The one who has arrogance even a little arrogance will not enter Paradise.
 (وَلَا تُصَعِّرُ خَدَّكَ لِلنَّاسِ)
- The one who walks arrogantly is disliked by Allah and also by humans. (وَلَا تَمْشِ فِي الْأَرْضِ مَوَحًا)

Revision (Hadith)

- We should always be prepared for death.
 How? By cleaning ourselves from sins
 through repentance. (--- الْعَابَدُ مَجَلَّ يَقْبَلُ تَوْبَةَ الْعَبَدِ---)
- Do not run after desires and greed because there is no end to them. (اَ حَبَ أَنْ يَّكُونَ لَهُ وَادِيَانِ)
- Seek help through patience. (وَالصَّبَرُ ضِيَاءٌ)





Walk with moderation!

Don't walk like a meek or sick person nor arrogantly. Be moderate in walking like that of a noble person.

If a person is angry and still speaks in low voice, it helps him to control the anger.

- Speaking the truth does not require a loud voice. (وَاغُضُضُ مِنْ صَوْتِكَ)
- Speaking in low voice helps in controlling the anger. (وَاغُضُضُ مِنْ صَوْتِكَ)

Revision (Hadith)

- Patience prevents a person from submitting to evil people. (وَمَنْ يَّتَصَبَّرُ يُصَبِّرُهُ اللهُ)
- Through patience, a person does not give up in problems. (وَمَنْ يَّتَصَبَّرُ يُصَبِّرُهُ اللهُ)
- A believer uses the prosperity for worship & charity. (إِنْ أَصَابَتُهُ سَرَّاءُ شَكَرَ)
