



# Muhammad is the Prophet and Messenger

- Allah made Muhammad ﷺ a prophet and a messenger at the age of 40.
- Nabi means to whom "نَبَأٌ" (news) came from Allah
- Rasool means the one to whom news as well as a book came.



## Makki period

- After receiving prophethood, the Prophet continued to invite people towards Islam for 13 years in Makkah.
- It is also called the Makki or Meccan period, and the years are called Nabawi (prophetic) years, i.e., 1<sup>st</sup> Nabawi till 13<sup>th</sup> Nabawi.



## Madani period

- After 13 years of Dawah in Makkah, the Prophet migrated to Madinah,
- There he preached for 10 years.
- This period is called Madani period. The years are Hijri years, i.e., 1<sup>st</sup> Hijri to 10<sup>th</sup> Hijri.
